

- **Prohibited Items**

The following is a general list of items that are prohibited for carriage in the aircraft cabin:

- Sharp objects
- Guns and firearms
- Tools
- Martial arts and self-defense items
- Explosive and flammable materials
- Disabling Chemicals
- Items considered dangerous or hazardous
- Samsung Note 7
- Hoverboards
- Electronic cigarettes



- **Transporting Firearms**

You may transport unloaded firearms in a locked hard-sided container as checked baggage only. Declare the firearm and/or ammunition with Eastern when checking your bag at the ticket counter. The container must completely secure the firearm from being accessed. Locked cases that can be easily opened are not permitted.

- **Lithium Batteries**

Portable electronic devices (e.g., watches, calculating machines, cameras, cellular phones, laptop and notebook computers, camcorders, medical devices etc.) containing dry cells or dry batteries (including lithium cells or batteries) and spare dry cells or batteries for these devices, may be carried by passengers for personal use. Portable electronic devices powered by lithium batteries may be carried in either checked or carry-on baggage; however, spare lithium batteries must be carried in carry-on baggage only. In the event that a carry-on bag has to be placed below in a cargo bin due to the size of the carry-on piece or capacity of the overhead bins in the cabin, any electronic device, lithium batteries, and spare batteries permitted in carry-on baggage must be removed from the carry-on bag and remain in the possession of the passenger in the passenger cabin.
